Is there evidence of a possible water leak(s) in your home or business?

Read your water meter at the end of the day when no more water will be used and turn humidifier(s) off. Read again in the morning before any water is used. Did the water meter reading change?

_____ **No.** Your home or business has passed and appears to be leak free. Monitor your consumption.

BATHROOM

TOILETS

Take notice of the water level in the toilet tank. The water level should never reach the top of the overflow tube.

Insert dye tablet in back roll of toilet tank and wait 15 minutes. Do not flush. If color appears in the toilet bowl, you have a leak (use dye tablets in every toilet in your home or business).

Drops coming from the showerhead.

PIPING UNDERNEATH BATHROOM SINKS

Drips coming from piping or wet, damp areas underneath the sink.

KITCHEN FAUCETS

Drips coming out of the faucet aerator or on/off handle(s).

Kitchen faucet appears to have a leak.

PIPING UNDERNEATH KITCHEN SINK

Drips coming from piping or wet, damp areas underneath the sink.

Piping underneath kitchen sink appears to have a leak.

DISHWASHER

Puddle of water accumulating in the front of the appliance.
