PROCLAMATION

DAY OF ACTION AGAINST ANTI-ASIAN RACISM

Whereas, the RCMP have reported a dramatic increase in anti-Asian hate crimes during the first year of the Covid-19 pandemic; and

Whereas, The Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms 15 (1) states that every individual is equal before and under the law and has the right to the equal protection and equal benefit of the law without discrimination and, in particular, without discrimination based on race, national or ethnic origin, colour, religion, sex, age, or mental or physical disability; and

Whereas, the City of Fort Saskatchewan strives to be a caring, inclusive, vibrant, safe, livable, and just city; and

Whereas, every resident in Fort Saskatchewan deserves safe public spaces without the fear of discrimination based on race, national or ethnic origin, colour, religion, sex, age, or mental or physical disability; and

Whereas, May is Asian Heritage Month in Canada;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Gale Katchur as Mayor of the City of Fort Saskatchewan and on behalf of City Council, hereby proclaim May 10th, 2021, as “**Day of Action Against Anti-Asian Racism**” in Fort Saskatchewan.
