RESULTS

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Introduction

The 2019 Municipal Census was conducted by the City of Fort Saskatchewan, Legislative Services Department.

This report provides data collected between April 1, 2019 and June 7, 2019 on the number of City residents in the home, the age and gender of each person, employment status, employment location, and length of residence in the City, as well as other information. Methods

Under the supervision of the Legislative Services Department, residents were able to complete the census online.

Enumerators entered census information electronically at each household which did not complete their census online prior to April 20, 2019.

This report represents the results of the census in tables and figures. Where possible, census data from 2018, 2017, 2016, and 2015 are provided for comparison and to identify population trends.

Results

Total Population

The total population of Fort Saskatchewan as of April 1, 2019 was 26,942 (Table 1). This includes 493 residents of the Fort Saskatchewan Correctional Centre. The population has increased by 614 residents in 2019 from 2018, which represents an increase of 2.33% (Table 2).

Table 4 and Figure 1 show that the 30-34 age group includes the most number of residents, followed closely by the 35-39 and the 25-29 age groups.

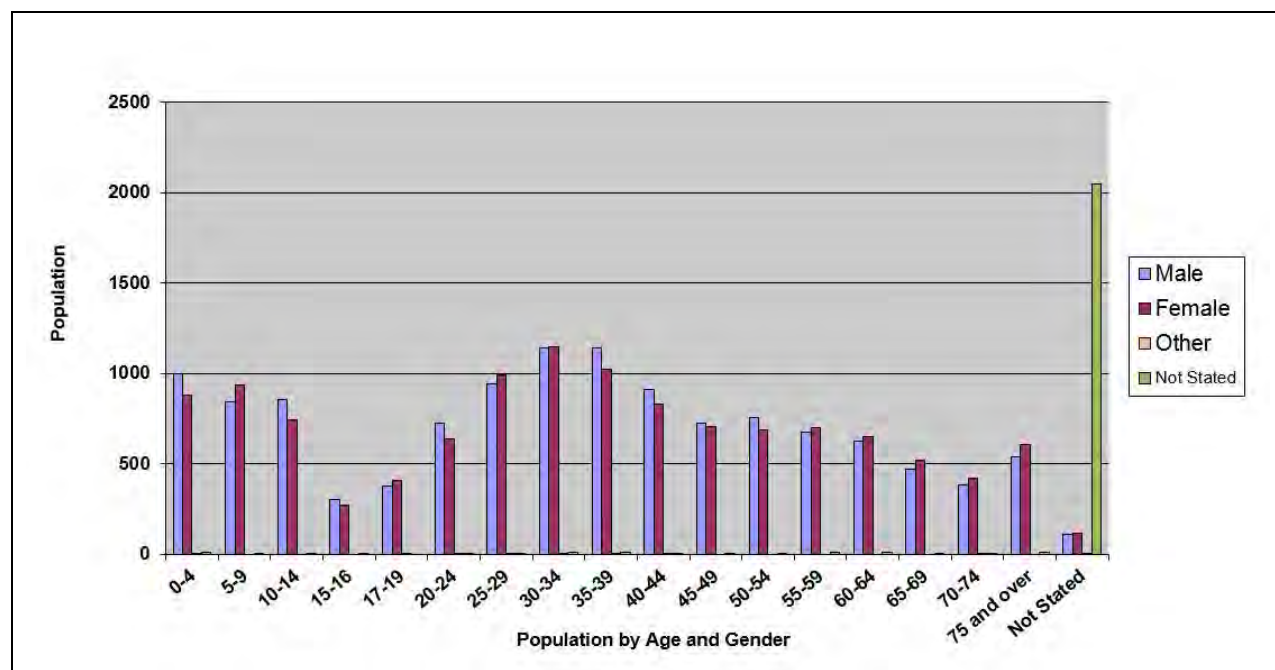

Dwelling Type

Single detached houses remain the predominant type of dwelling in Fort Saskatchewan (Table 7). Apartments, duplexes, and row houses are the next popular dwelling types for Fort Saskatchewan. Vacant dwellings were recorded at 595 (Table 6) and there was a total of 974 no responses for this question.

Figure 2. Employment Status

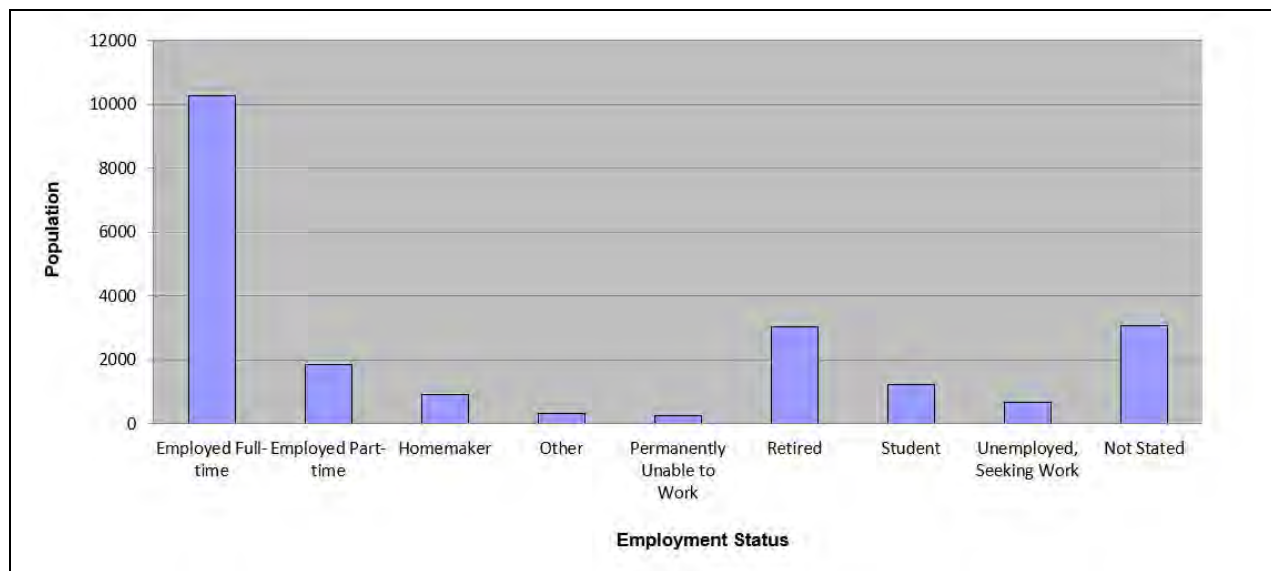


Figure 3. Employment Status by Gender

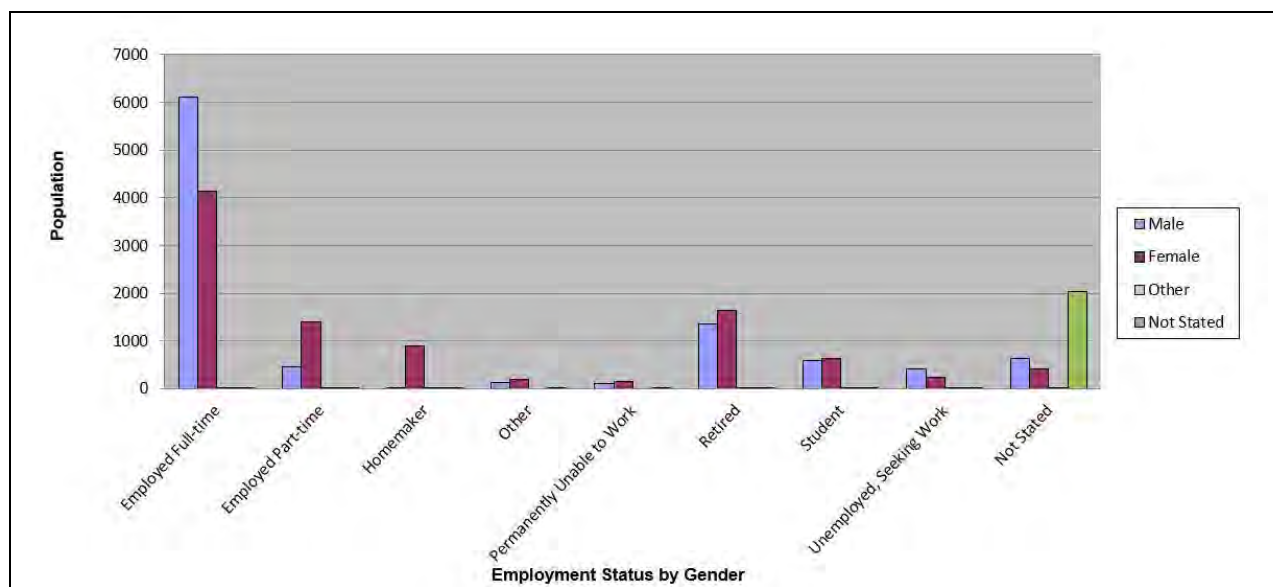
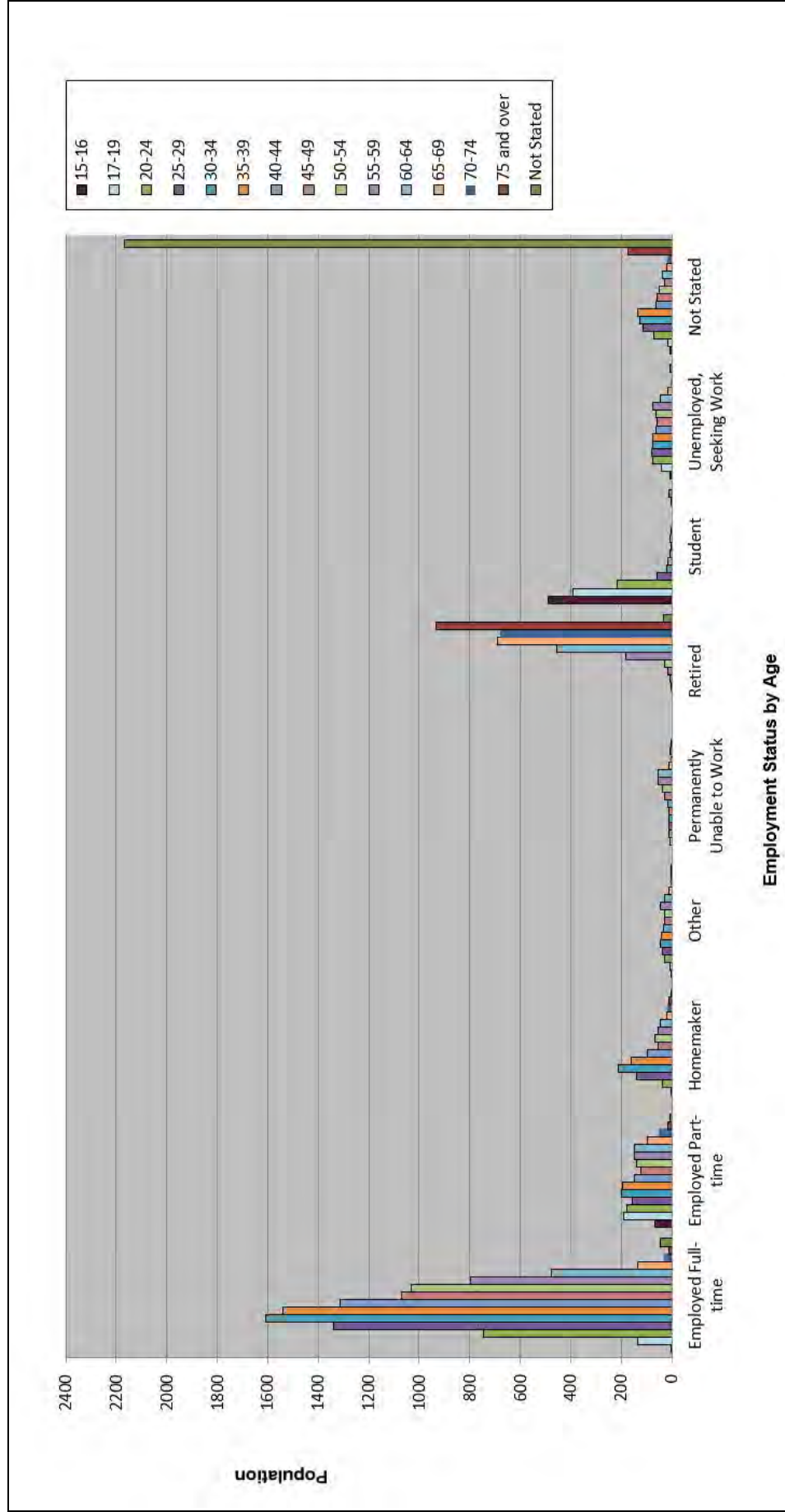

Figure 5. Employment Location

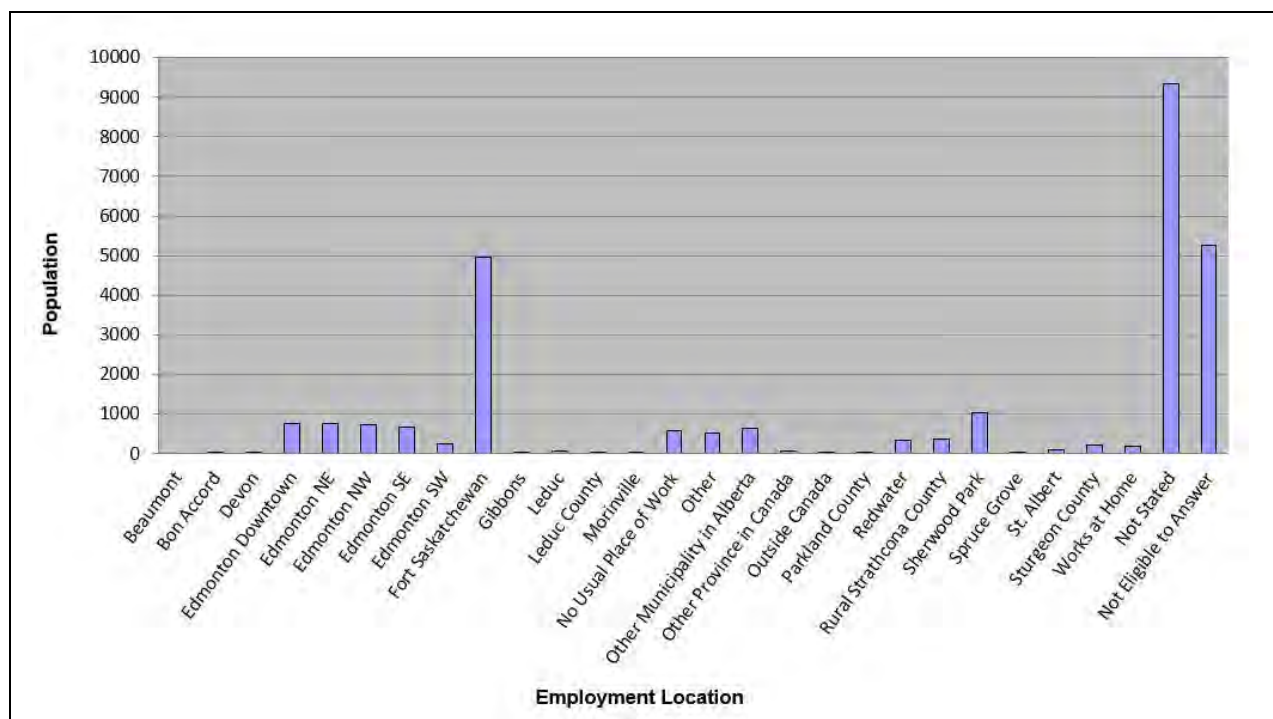


Figure 6. Employment Location by Gender

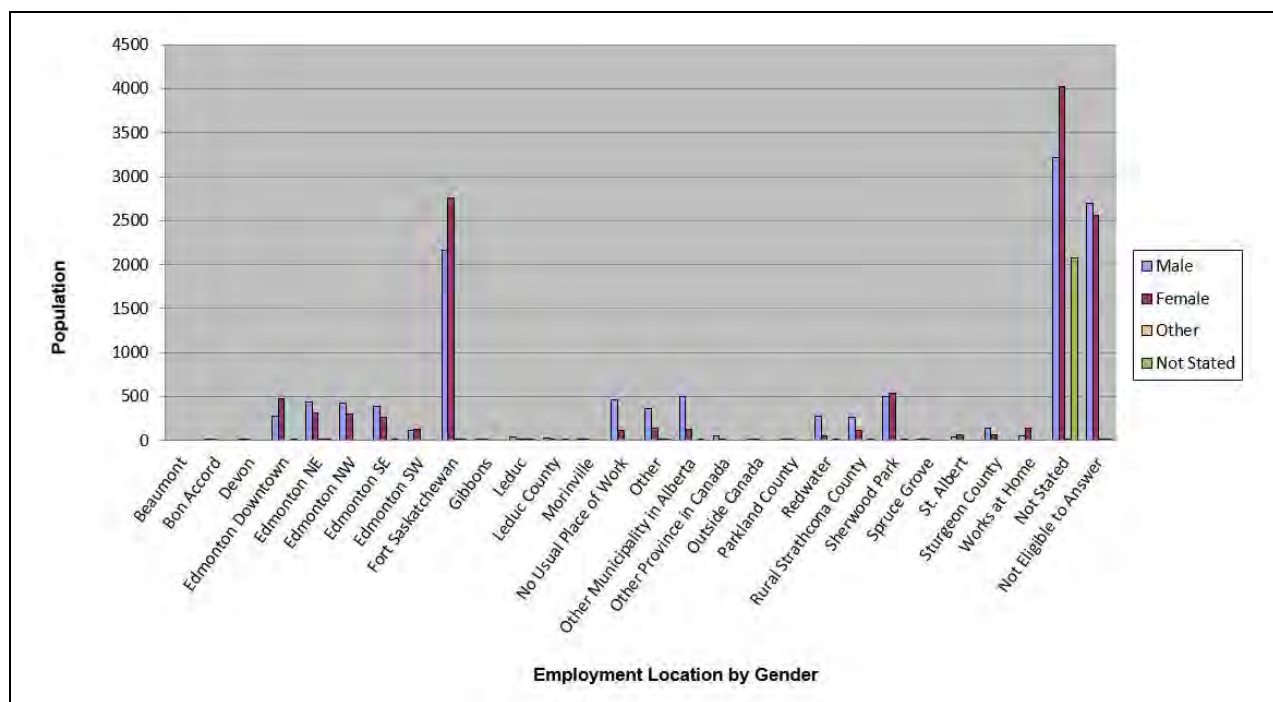

Figure 7. Main Mode of Transportation

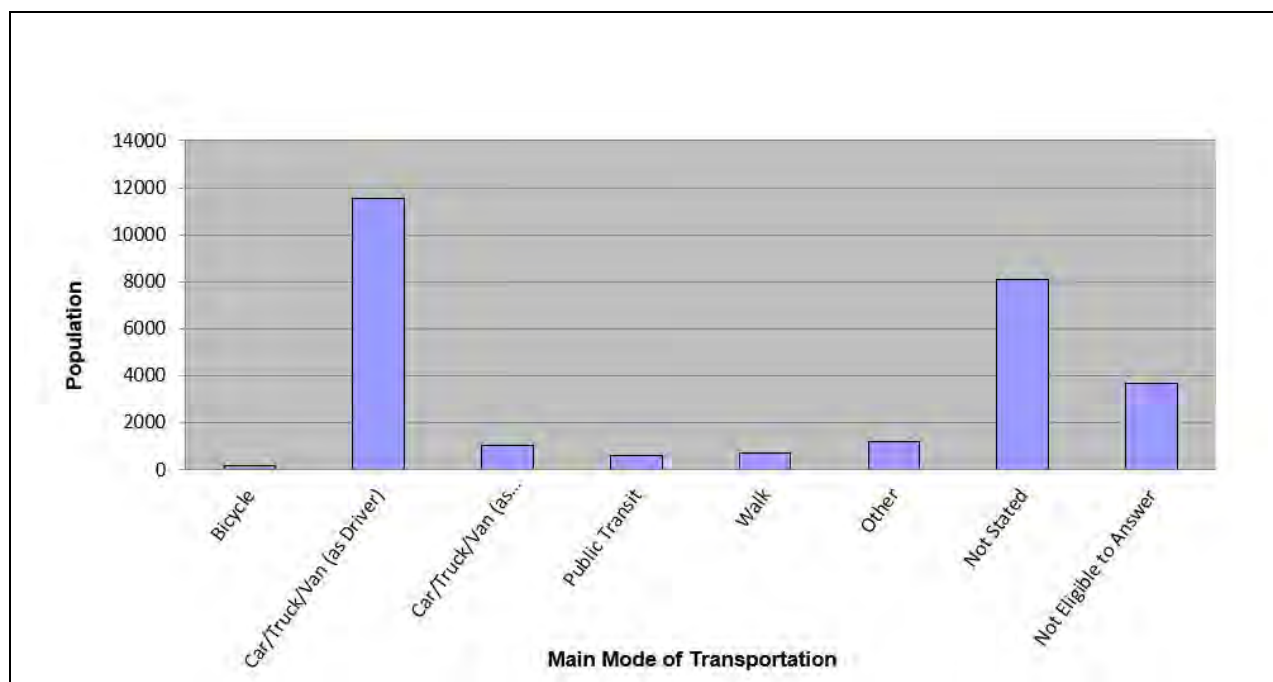


Figure 8. Main Mode of Transportation by Gender

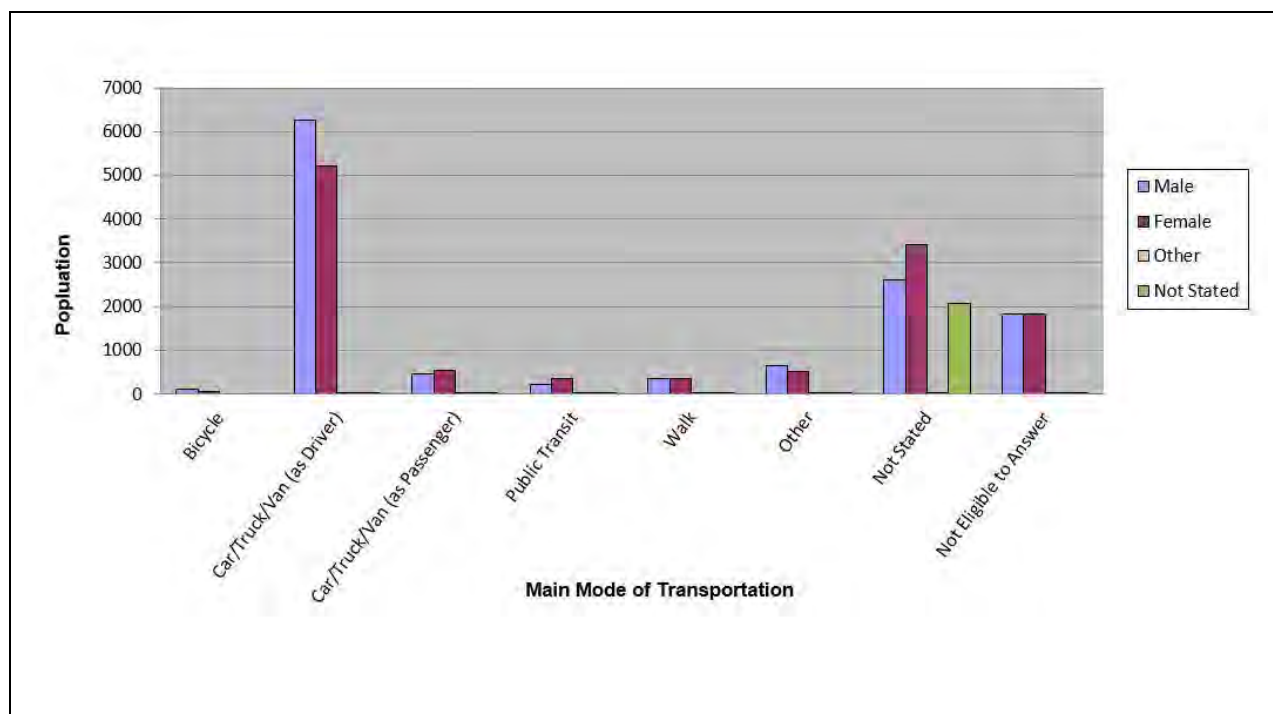
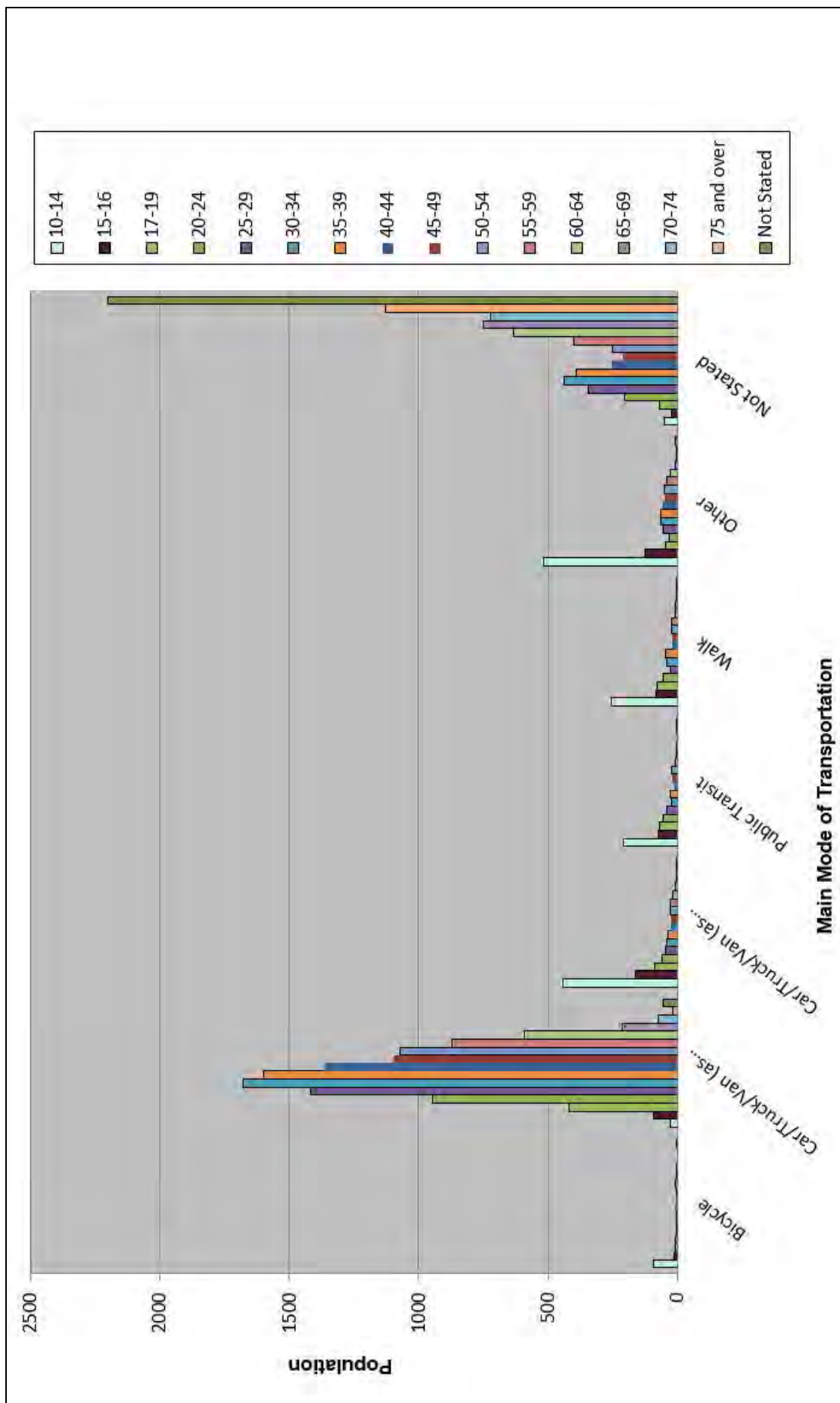

Figure 10. Length of Residency

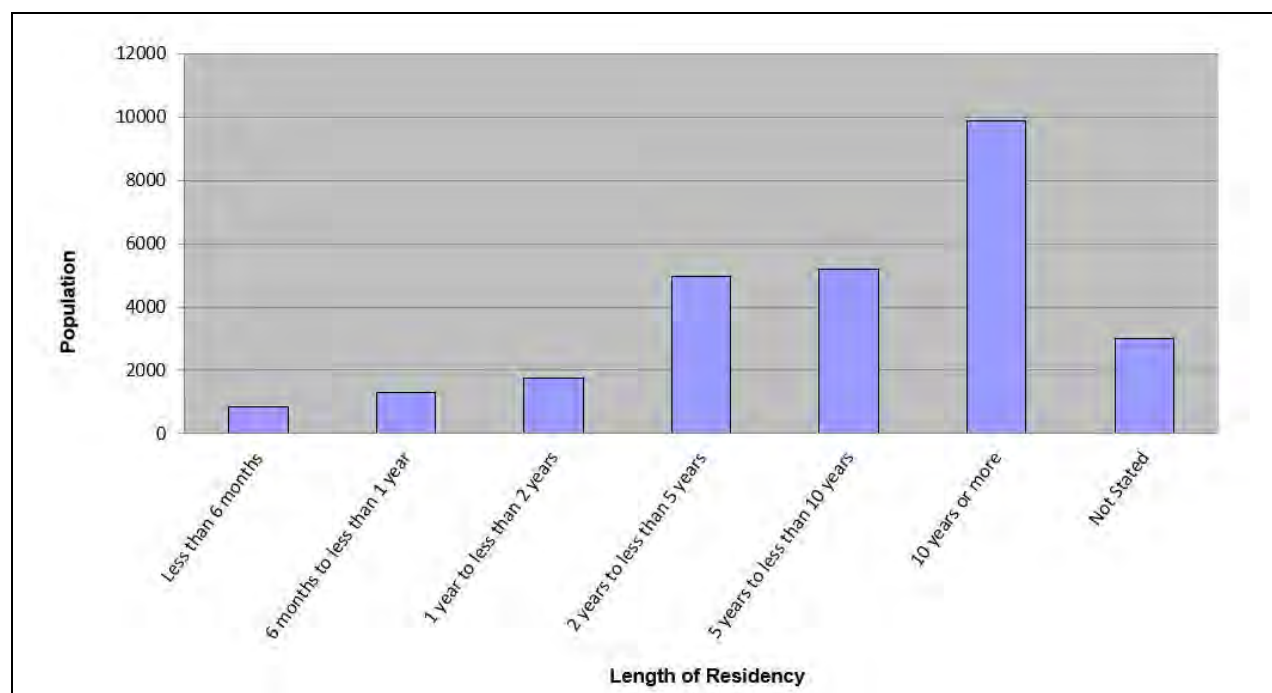


Figure 11. Length of Residency by Gender

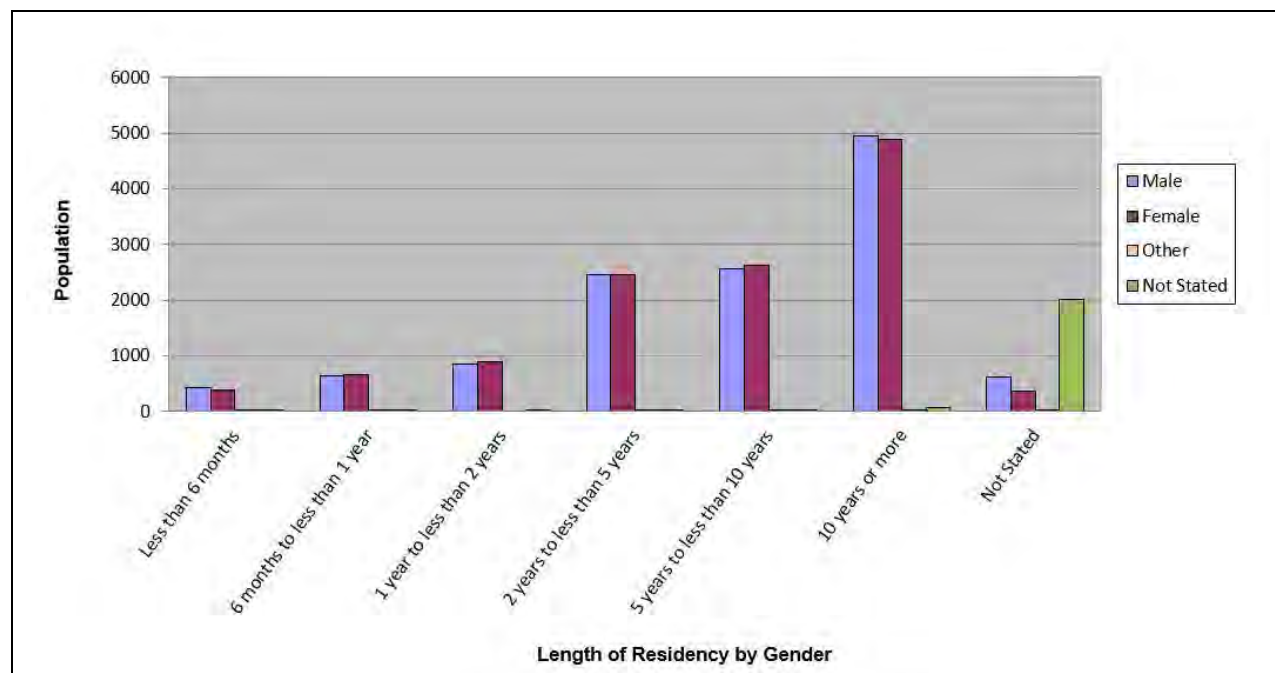
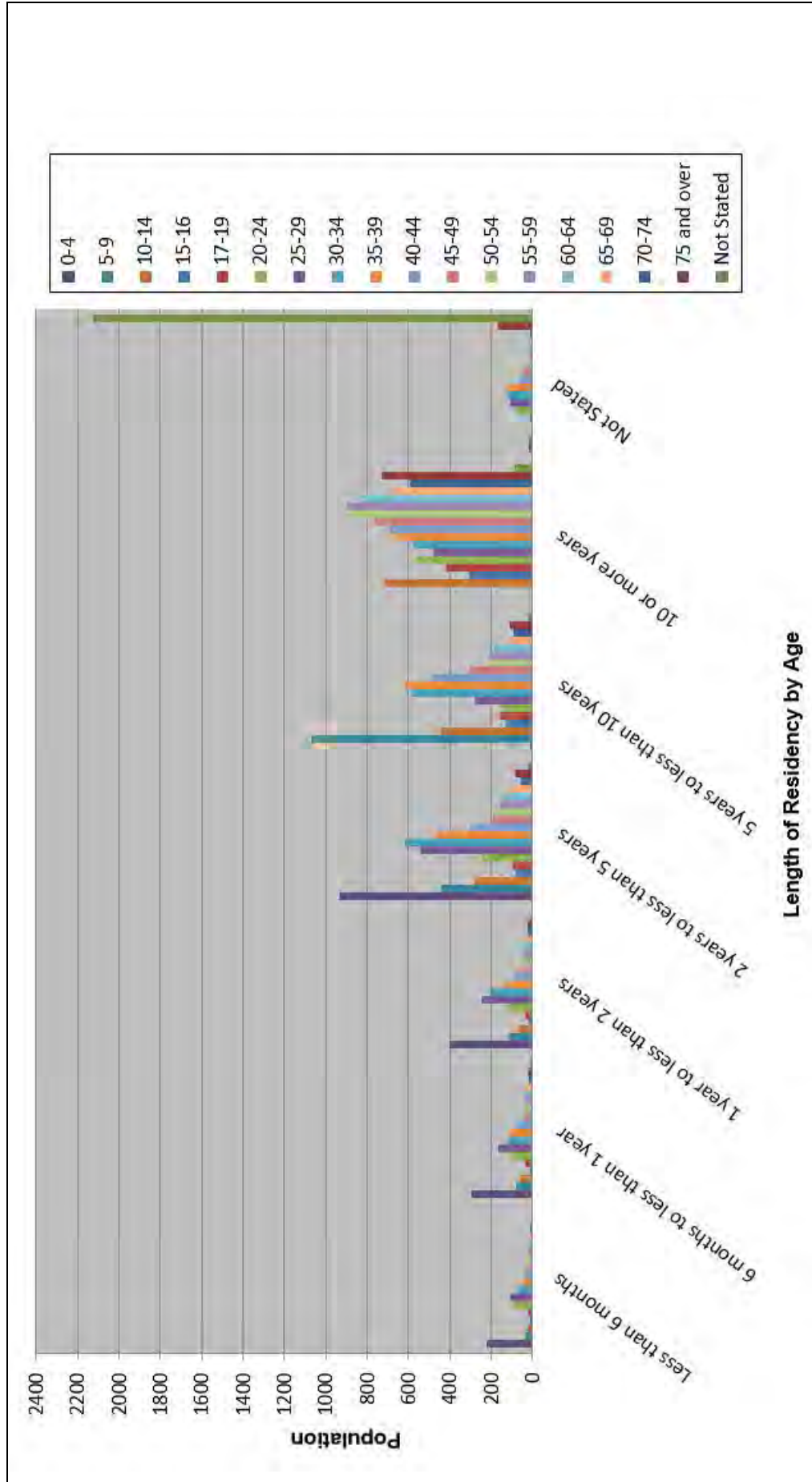

Figure 13. Level of Education

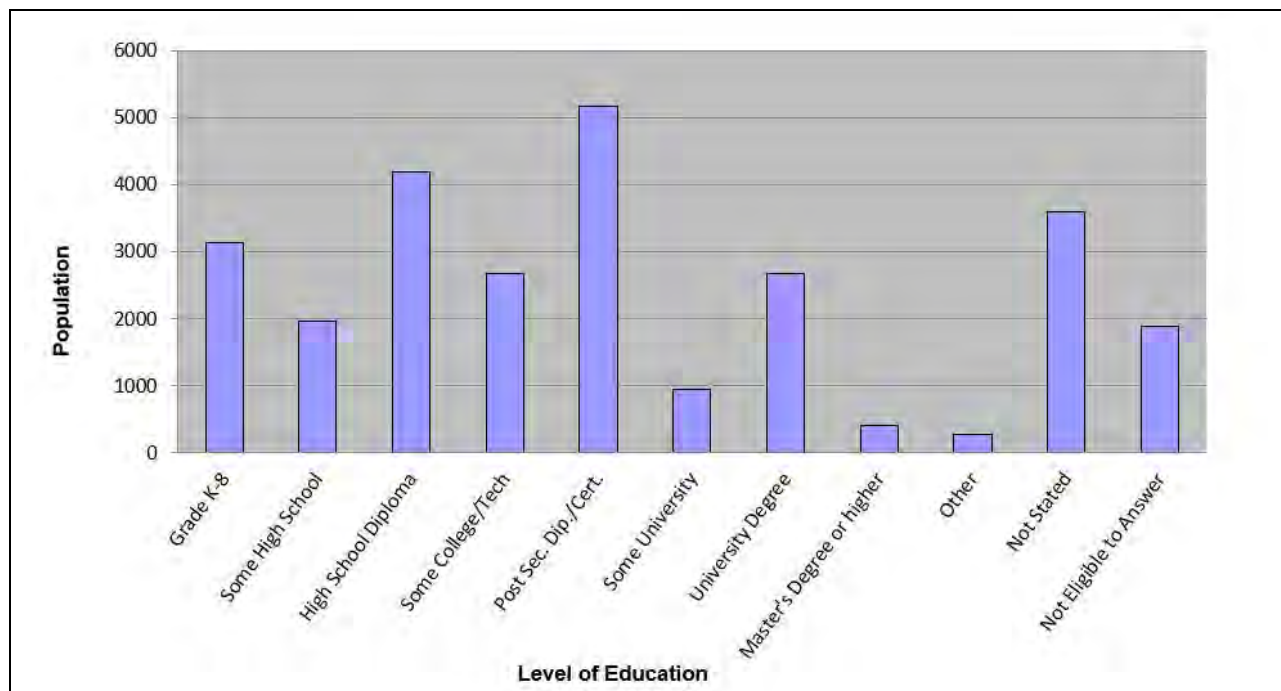


Figure 14. Level of Education by Gender

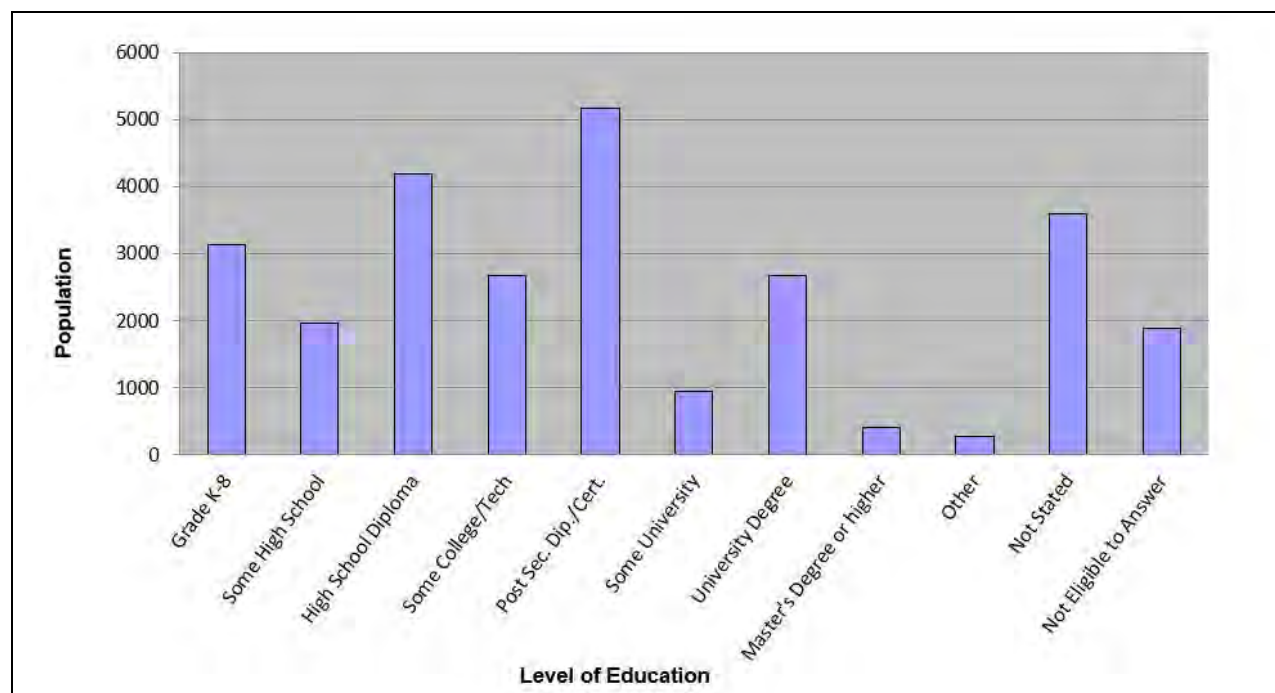
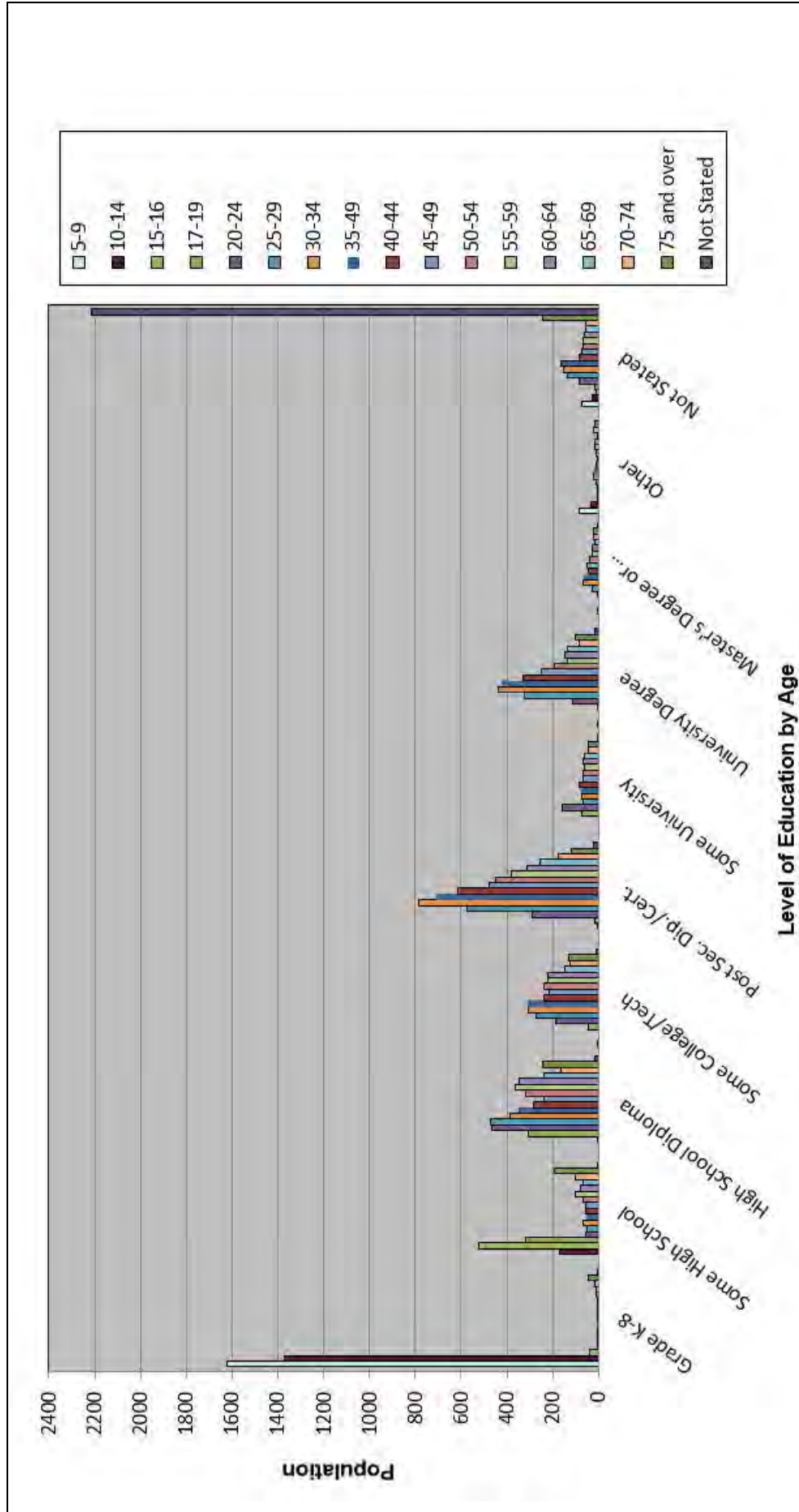

Figure 16. Language Spoken at Home

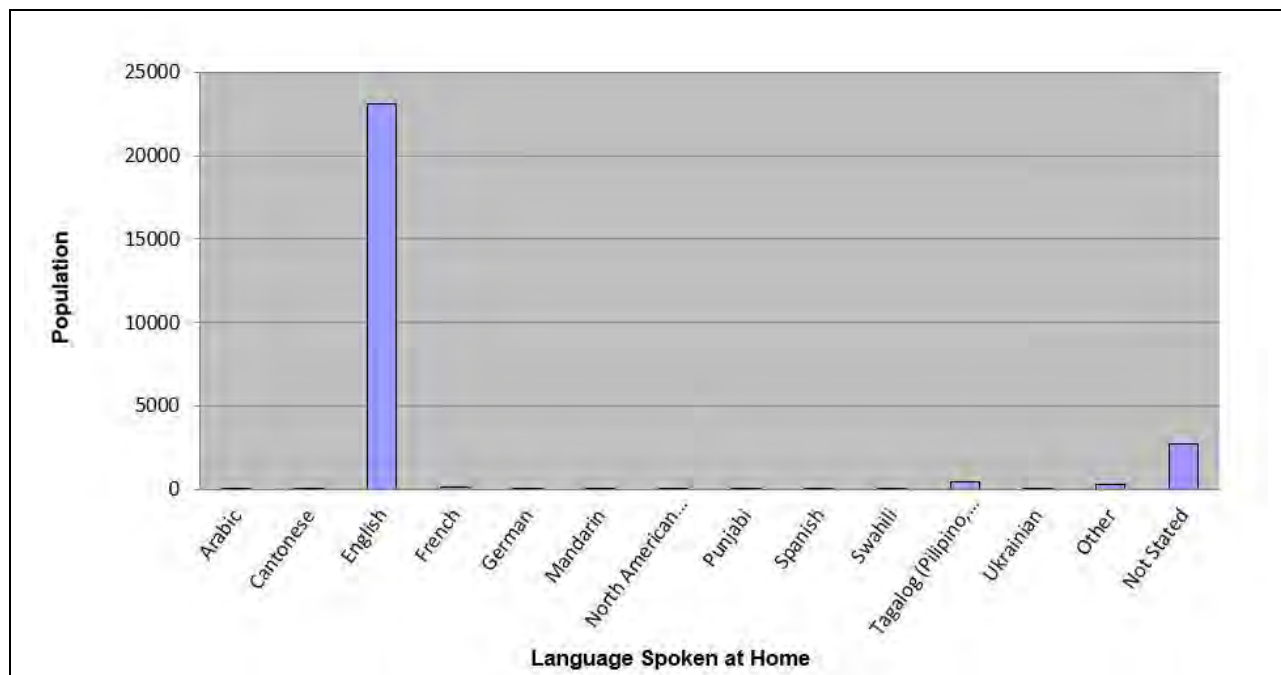


Figure 17. Language Spoken at Home by Gender

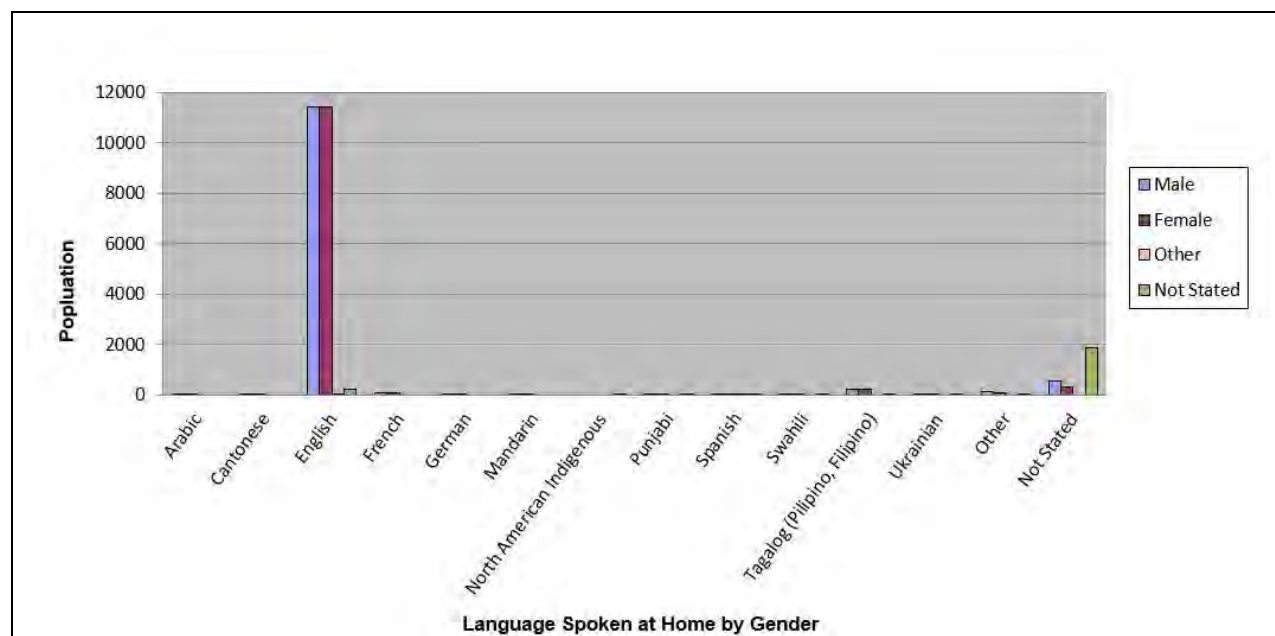
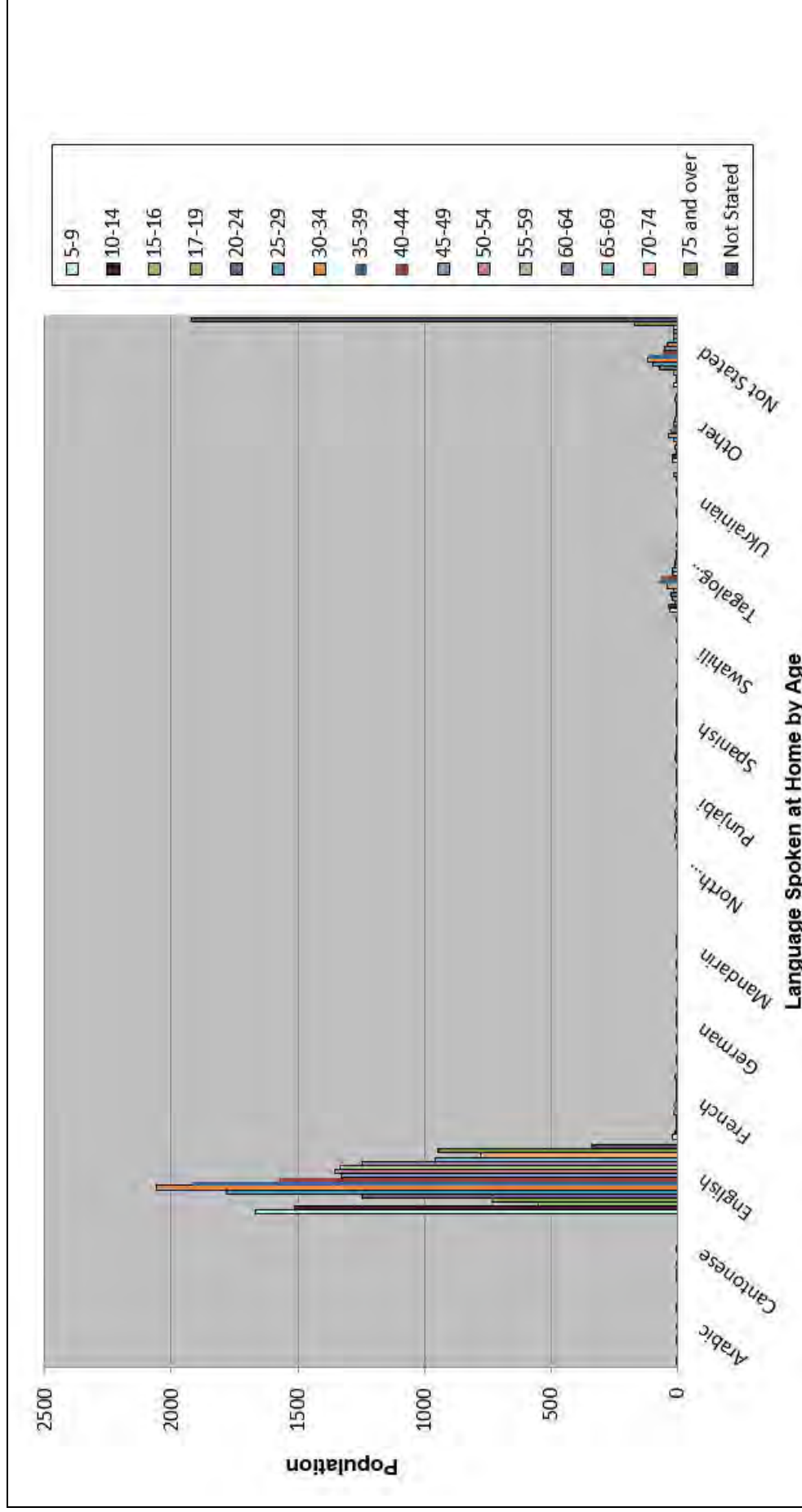

Figure 19. Volunteering

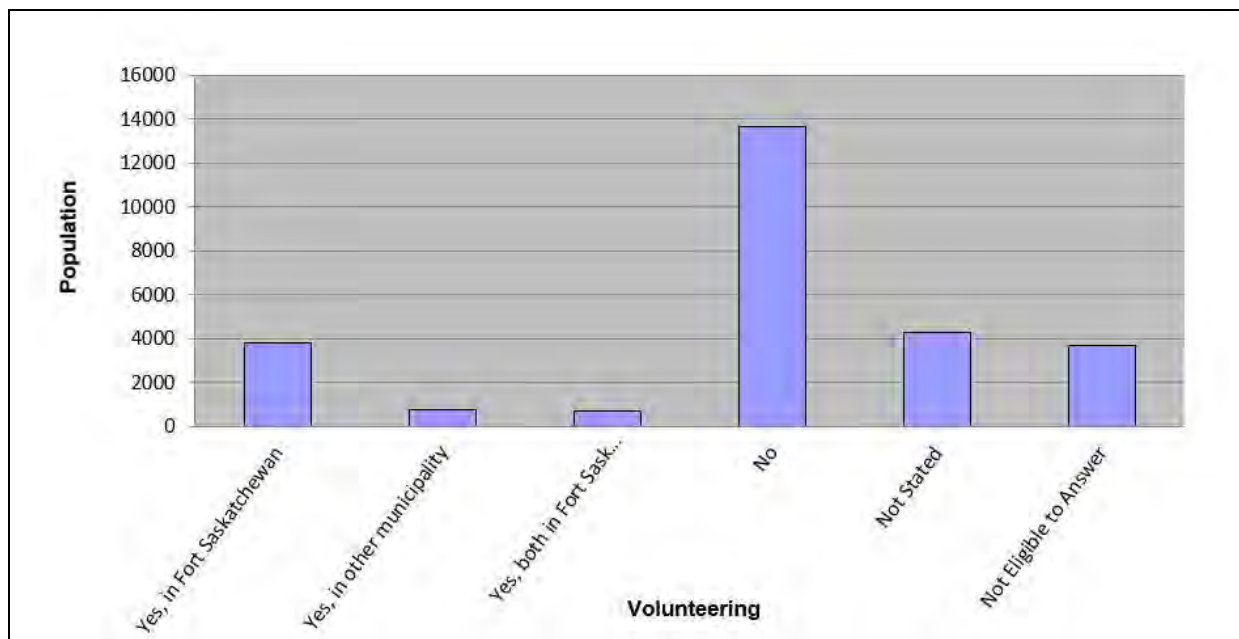


Figure 20. Volunteering by Gender

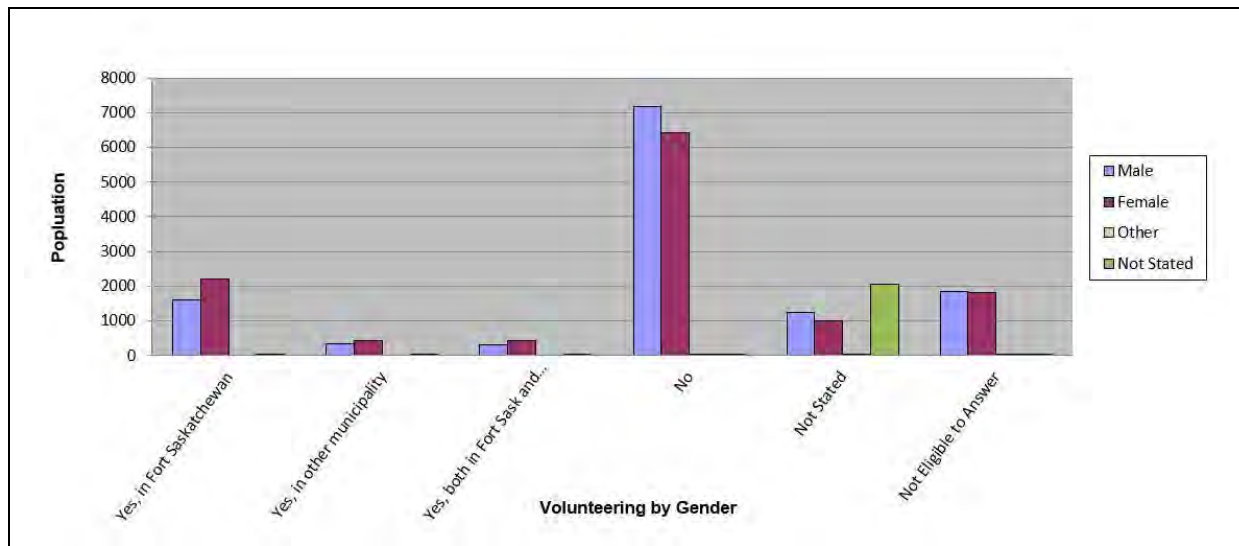
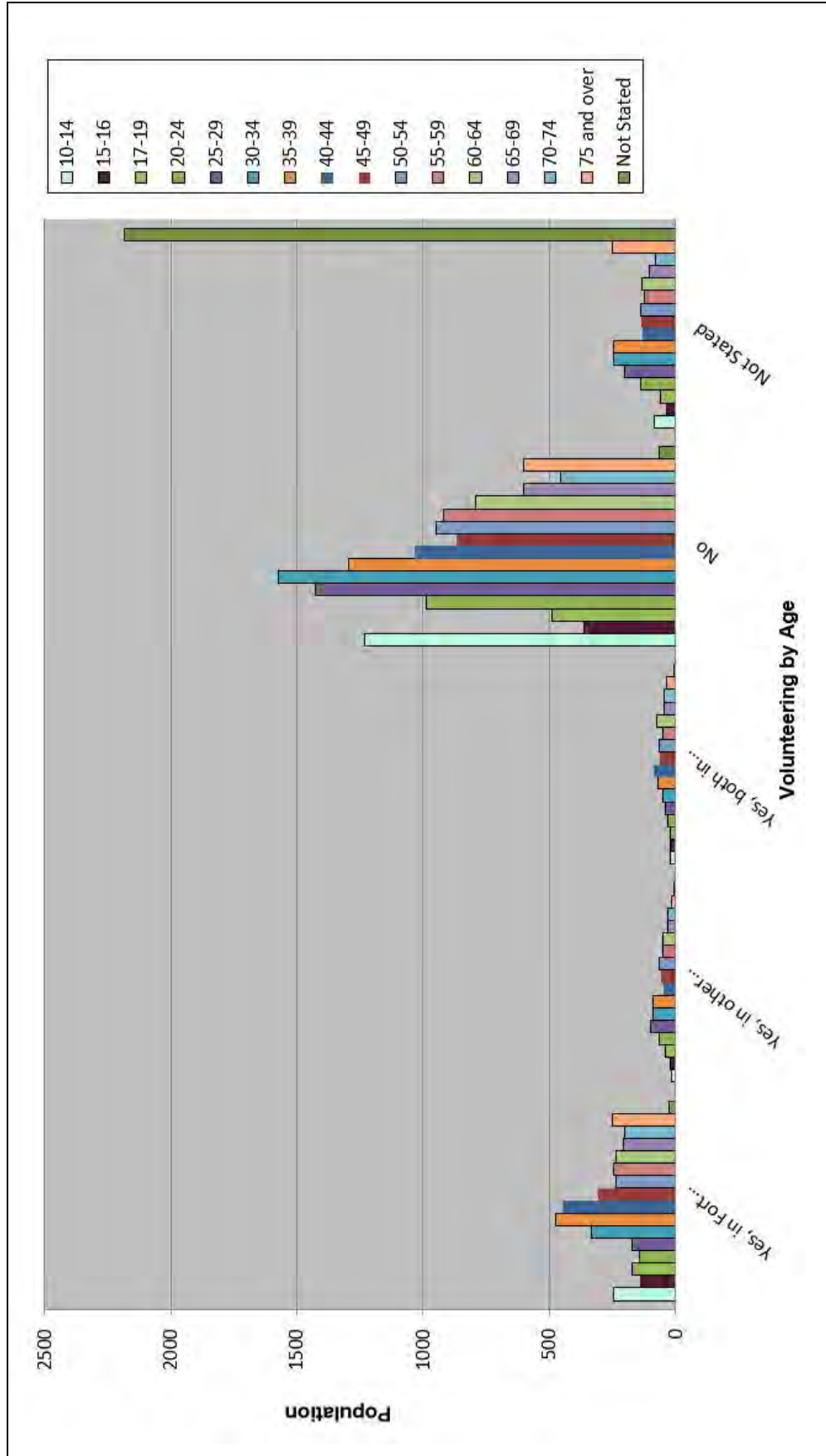

Figure 22. Population by Enumeration Area (101-308)

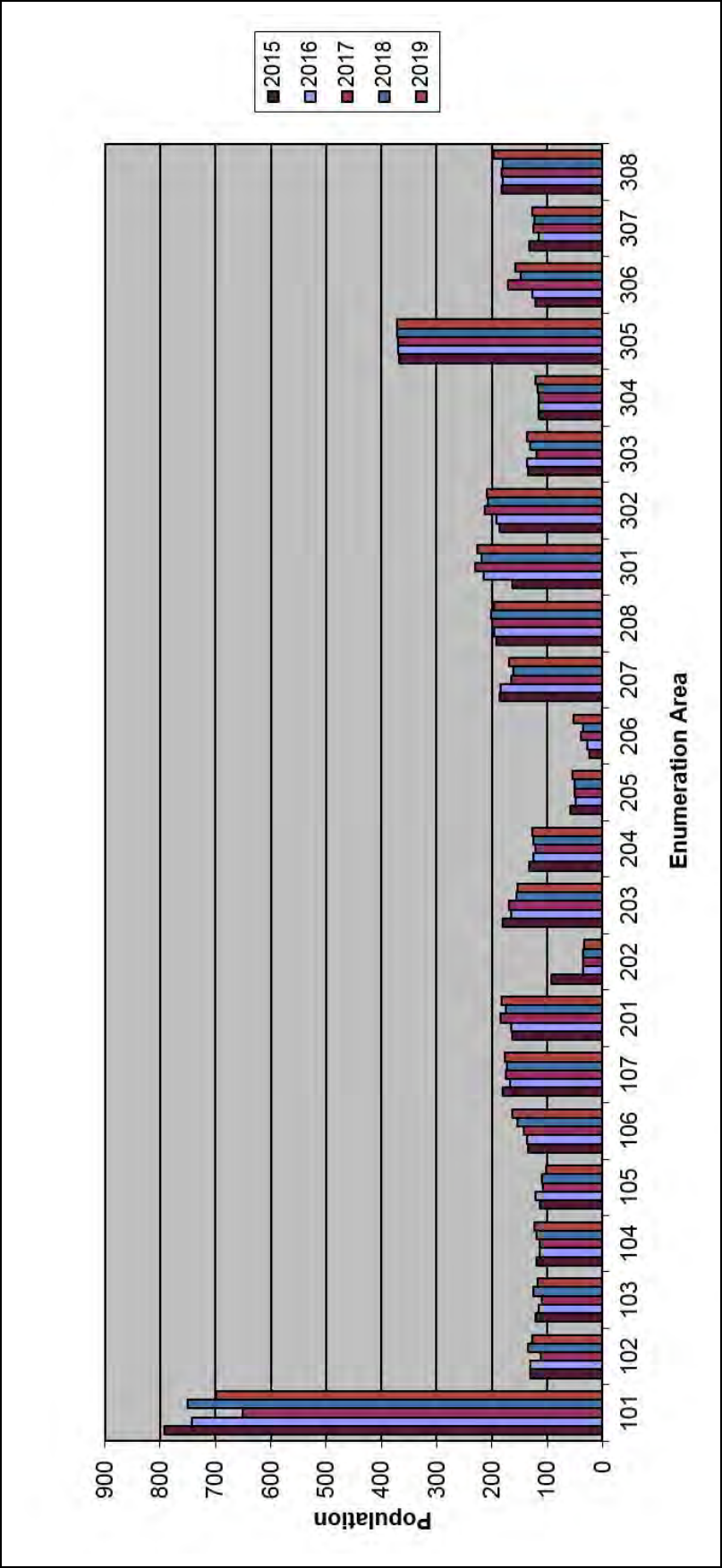


Figure 23. Population by Enumeration Area (309-507)

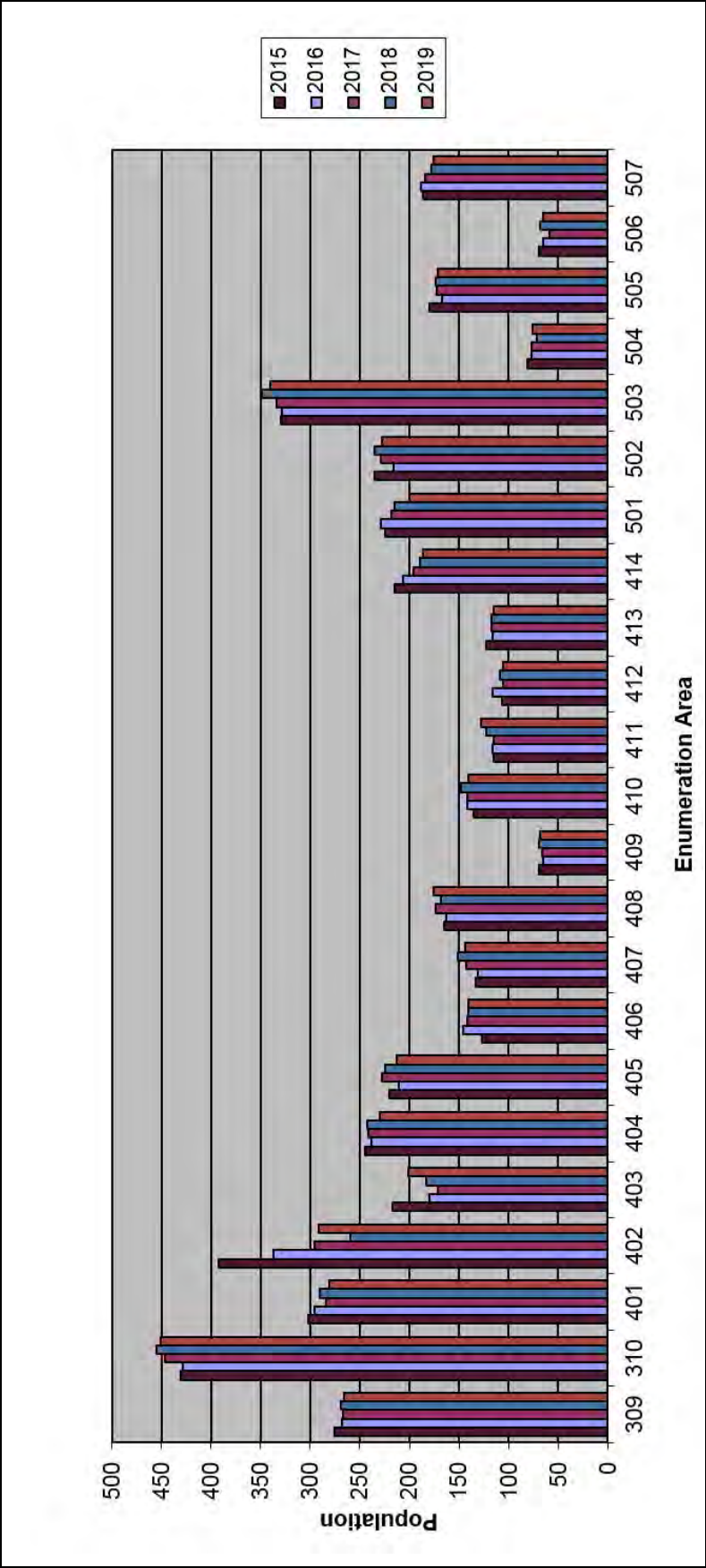


Figure 24. Population by Enumeration Area (508-709)

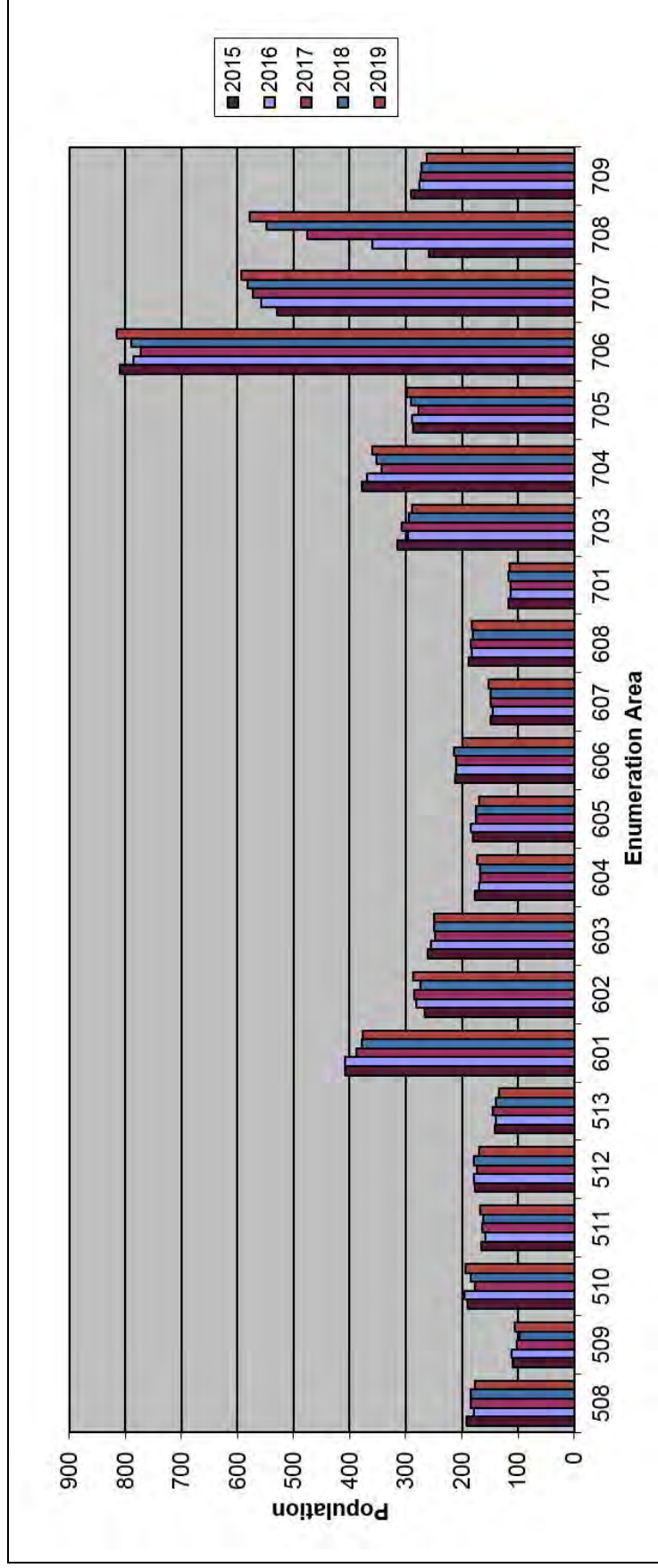
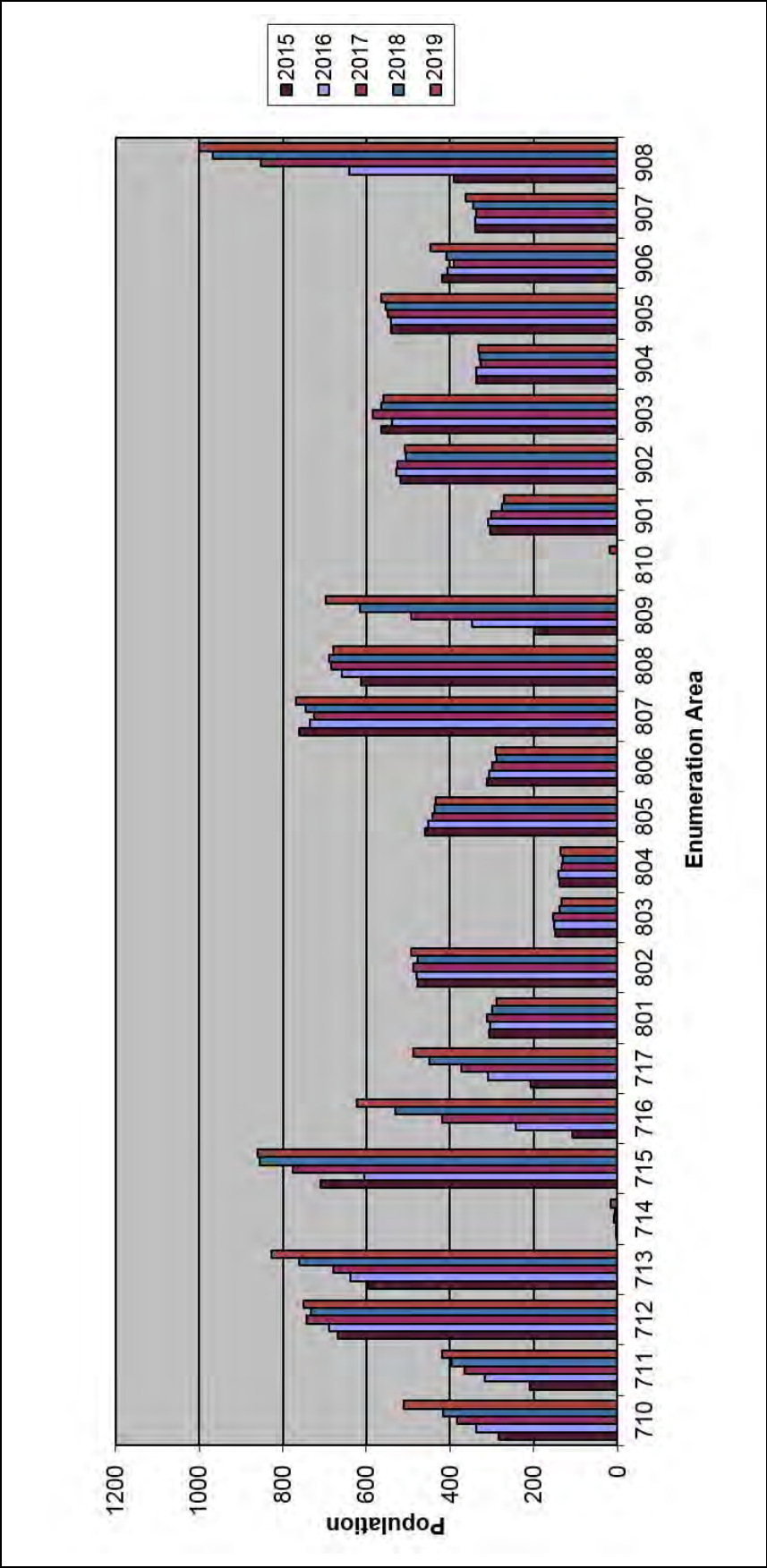
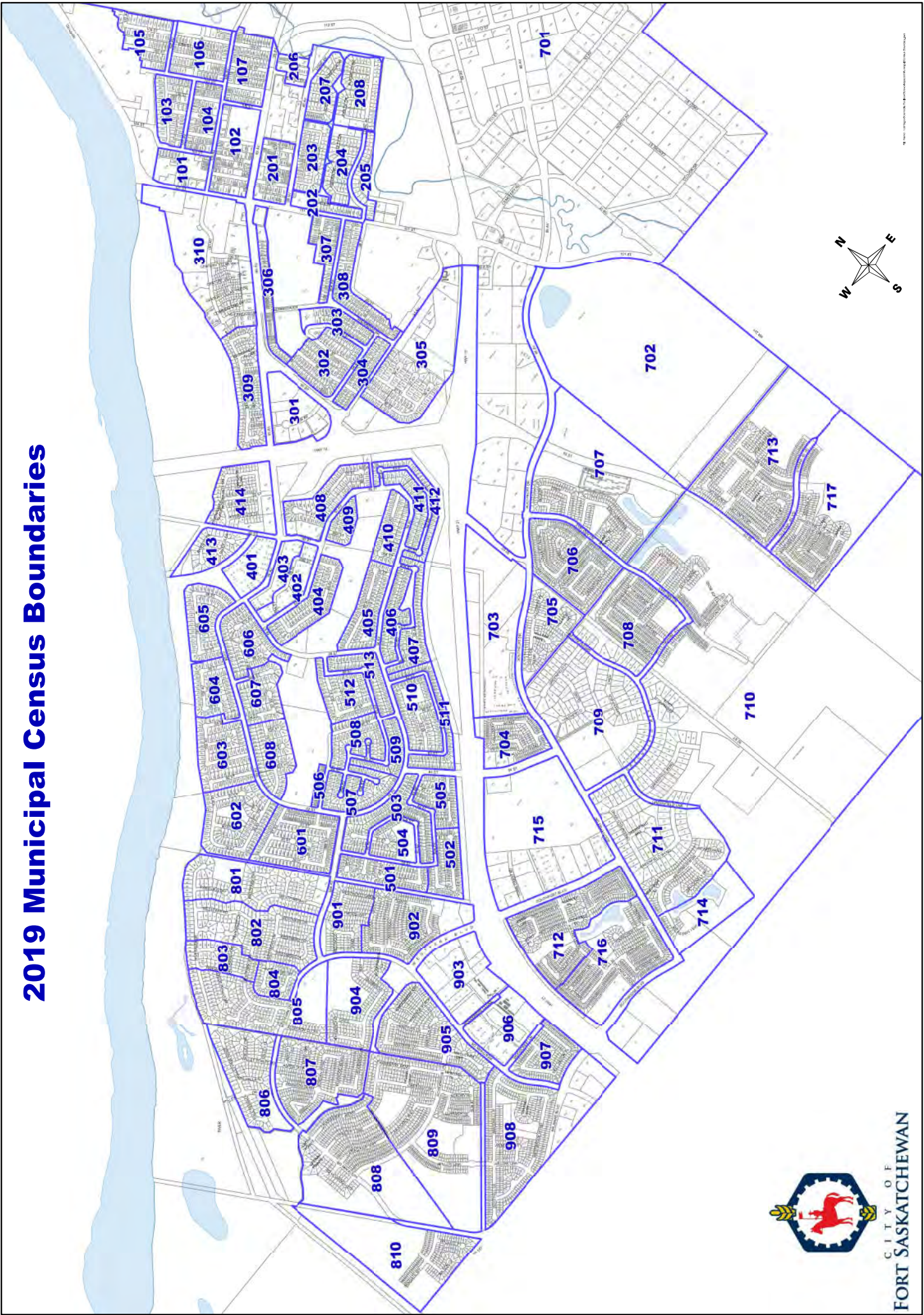


Figure 25. Population by Enumeration Area (710-908)
