Introduction

The 2014 Municipal Census was conducted by the City of Fort Saskatchewan, Corporate and Protective Services Division, Legislative Services Department.

This report provides data collected between April 28, 2014 and June 9, 2014 on the number of residents in the home, the age and gender of each, employment status, employment location, and length of residence in this municipality as well as other information. Methods

Under the supervision of the Legislative Services Department of the Corporate and Protective Services Division, residents were able to complete the census online.

Enumerators only visited households that did not submit an electronic census by May 19, 2014 and entered the information electronically right at their door.

This report presents the results of the census in tables and figures. Where possible, census data from 2013, 2012, 2010 and 2009 are provided for comparison and to identify population trends.

Results

Total Population

The total population of Fort Saskatchewan as of April 28, 2014 was 22,808 (Table 1). This includes 489 residents of the Fort Saskatchewan Correctional Centre. The population increased by 1,013 residents from 2014 to 2013, which represents an increase of 4.65 percent (Table 2).

Population by Gender

The proportion of males in Fort Saskatchewan has decreased over the past three years. In 2014, 50.6 percent of the population is male, while 47.4 percent is female (Table 3).





Dwelling Type

Employment Status


The Employment Status results show that 44.8% of respondents are employed full time and that Fort Saskatchewan has a 1.7% unemployment rate.

Figure 2. Employment status







Figure 3. Employment status by gender

Figure 5. Employment location




Figure 6. Employment location by gender



Length of Residency



Figure 7. Length of residency






Figure 8. Length of residency by gender




Figure 9. Length of residency by age

Figure 10. Level of education




Figure 11. Level of Education by gender






Figure 13. Language spoken at home






Figure 14. Language spoken at home by gender




Figure 15. Language spoken at home by age

Figure 16. Local News Source




Figure 17. Local News Source by Gender







