## BYLAW NO. 1713

BEING a Bylaw of the Town of Fort Saskatchewan to provide for a permit and for an advance performance deposit where persons excavate, trench or dig up any Town street or public right-of-way.

WHEREAS it may be necessary for a property owner, a contractor or any person to excavate, trench or dig up Town streets for installing utility services or any other reason.

AND WHEREAS problems may arise in having the streets repaired to original standards.

NOW THEREFORE, Council duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT a permit shall be obtained from the Town before any work whatsoever be commenced on any Town street or public right-of-way except those who may be permitted to do so by Franchise Agreement or Provincial or Federal government regulations.
- 2. THAT the application for a permit shall be accompanied by a plan or drawing showing in detail the work to be done.
- 3. THAT the applicant shall deposit with the Town, a performance deposit in the form of a Letter of Credit, certified cheque, cash or money order in the amount of the estimated cost to repair the street or public right-of-way to the acceptable standard as may be determined by the Town's Operations Superintendent from time to time.
- 4. THAT the Operations Superintendent of the Town is hereby authorized to determine the amount of deposit and the time required to restore the street or public right-of-way in a satisfactory manner depending on the complexity of the work.
- 5. THAT upon completion of repairs to the street or public right-of-way in a manner that is satisfactory to the Operations Superintendent the deposit will be refunded in full to the applicant without any accrued interest.
- 6. THAT if the street repairs are not satisfactorily completed and upon the Town giving the applicant Ten days notice by personal delivery or registered mail to have the repair work completed, the Town may order the work done or have it done by the Town work forces and funds from the advance deposit shall be used to pay the cost of the repairs.
- 7. THAT if the amount of the deposit does not cover the full cost of the repairs, the Town shall demand further payment and if any portion of the deposit remains unspent after full repair costs are paid, the balance shall be refunded to the applicant.

READ a first time in Council this 8th day of November 1976.

READ a second time in Council this 8th day of November 1976.

With unanimous consent of all members present, Bylaw No. 1713 was presented for third reading.

READ a third time in Council and passed this 8th day of November 1976.
